WHAT IS THE REVALUATION PROCESS?

Revaluation is a process where all property (land and buildings) within a taxing jurisdiction (in this case Mecklenburg County) is revalued to its current market value as of an established date. State law requires the County to conduct a property revaluation at least every eight years to determine its market value.

COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- ▶ Meet with the County Assessor, County management and staff.
- ▶ Review the overall operations and statistical reports related to the County's 2023 Revaluation.
- ▶ Provide updates and reports to County Board of County Commissioners.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- ▶ Must be a resident of Mecklenburg County.
- ▶ Must be able to meet once a month from March 2022 – December 2022.



The deadline to submit an application is December 30, 2021.
