



Mecklenburg County Assessor's Office Antique Vehicle Notification

Dear Antique Vehicle Owner,

You will soon receive a bill for an automobile that carries an antique automobile license plate. The North Carolina General Statutes allow special taxation for these automobiles, provided they meet certain qualifications under the law.

In order to determine whether this automobile should receive the special tax valuation, you will need to complete the enclosed questionnaire and return it to our office within five (5) business days.

Your failure to timely fill this information could result in the automobile being assessed at a much higher value. This information is necessary to determine the assessed value of the vehicle. After receipt of your application, additional information may be required in order to grant the reduction.

Antique Automobile Value Exclusion Application

Pursuant to N.C.G.S. §105-330.9, antique automobiles are designated a special class of property under Article V, Sec. 2(2) of the North Carolina Constitution and are eligible for assessment at a reduced tax valuation. If qualified, they shall be assessed at the lower of their true value or five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

To determine qualification, the owner must **file an affirmation with the assessor of the county in which the property is located** that all five conditions of the statute have been met. This form, or any appeal of initial value, must be filed **within 30 days of the date the taxes are due**. The assessor reserves the right to deny the qualification of any automobile deemed not to qualify.
