Primary Series

The CDC recommends the Pfizer and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines for children ages 6 months and older. The primary series is 2 doses, just like yours, but the dosage is lower.


Third Dose

Immunocompromised children ages 6 months to 17 years should get a third dose of the Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine after their second dose of the primary series.

Booster Dose





Children ages 5-17 should get a Pfizer booster dose after the primary series. Immunocompromised teens ages 12-17 should also get a second Pfizer booster dose after the first Pfizer booster.
