Now Accepting Proposals for Affordable Supportive Housing

The City of Charlotte and Mecklenburg County are now jointly accepting proposals for Supportive Housing Developments and/or Supportive Housing Programs. The coordinated effort includes funds for supportive services and housing development.

The intent of the joint Request for Proposal (RFP) is to provide a collaborative and streamlined application and review process between the City and Mecklenburg, County. The following funding is available for the Fiscal Year 2015 program year:

- City of Charlotte Neighborhood & Business Services (NBS):
Up to \$1,500,000 allocated for development from the Housing Trust Fund. Development can include new construction, rehabilitation and acquisition/rehabilitation.
- Mecklenburg County Community Support Services (CSS):
Up to \$800,000 allocated for supportive services over two to three fiscal years, depending on recipient performance, funding availability and the eligible population served.
