Notification of Compliance Status Submittal  
National Perchloroethylene Air Emission Standards for Dry Cleaning Facilities

In accordance with the Mecklenburg County Air Pollution Control Ordinance (“MCAPCO”) Regulation 2.1111 – “**Maximum Achievable Control Technology**,” which refers to 40 CFR 63 Subpart M, National Perchloroethylene Air Emission Standards for Dry Cleaning Facilities, section § 63.324(f) requires that each owner or operator of a dry cleaning facility shall submit to Mecklenburg County Air Quality (MCAQ) by registered mail on or before July 28, 2008 a notification of compliance status.

MCAQ is providing the enclosed form for you to complete. Several definitions are provided on the back of the form. An entire copy of the 40 CFR 63 Subpart M is enclosed. Please complete the enclosed form for each different dry cleaning plant location that your company owns. **The form has to be certified and signed by a responsible official of your company.** Keep a copy of the completed form for your records. **By July 28, 2008, mail the signed original by Registered Mail to:**
