# CONTINUITY CRITICAL PROJECTS

## Basic Rules:

**Inspection by Appointment (IBA) Coordinator** must verify with Field Inspector, Inspections Supervisor/Assistant Core Process Manager or Core Process Manager that the project is **not** continuity critical.

**Definition of Continuity Critical:** A project deemed critical in which IBA inspections must be performed by the area assigned or “regular” field staff to maintain integrity within the inspection process.

**Projects include the following but are not limited to:**

- Complex jobs in which information or construction designs have been discussed in detail with regular field staff and base upon complexity should remain with assigned inspector
- Engineered judgments or special interpretation projects
- Large jobs requiring multiple partial inspections that would be difficult for IBA Inspectors to know what has been previously inspected
- Projects with open non-conformance issues

**\*If deemed to be continuity critical, the regular field inspector must fill the time slot requested (after availability is confirmed with field staff) and the IBA Inspector will rotate to that inspector’s area to cover as needed.**
