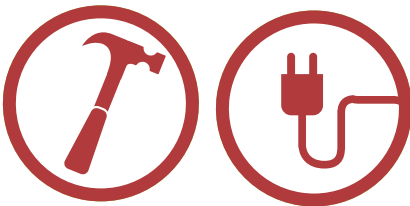


# PERMITTING FOR TEMPORARY TESTING & VACCINATION FACILITIES DURING COVID-19

## PERMITS ARE REQUIRED

under North Carolina law for temporary facilities that are placed on-site for COVID-19 testing and/or vaccination. This includes tents and hard-walled structures, like pre-fabricated sheds.



## BUILDING AND ELECTRICAL PERMITS & INSPECTIONS

are usually involved, but permitting and inspections requirements can vary depending on the specifics of the temporary facility.
