Mecklenburg County's event recycling program enables event organizers to collect and recycle cardboard, plastic bottles, glass bottles, and aluminum cans from street fairs, concerts, sporting events, and other community events. The event can be large or small, in your neighborhood or in the greater community.

The Event Recycling Program provides website information, educational materials, presentations, and hands-on training, as well as an Event Recycling Toolkit. A refundable deposit is required for the use of a predetermined number of Clear Stream upright recycling containers and collections bags.
