Materials Accepted at Full-Service Recycling Centers:

Recycled Materials

Jugs, Plastic Bottles, Aluminum Cans, Glass, Cardboard, Metal Appliances. These items are accepted at no charge from Mecklenburg County residents.

Bulky Waste

Non-spoilable items that may include furniture, couches, tables, clothes, mattresses and box springs, styrofoam, and other such items.

Household Hazardous Waste

Accepted at NO charge from Mecklenburg County residents. Chemicals, Fertilizers, Batteries, Paints, and other potentially hazardous items found in homes.

Construction & Demolition Waste (C&D)

The waste material generated in the construction, renovation or removal of structures. C&D debris may include concrete, brick, block, wood, gypsum, asphalt pavement and shingles, metal, miscellaneous plastics, carpet, carpet padding, windows, doors, fixtures, and wood, as well as land-clearing debris.



Yard Waste

Materials such as brush, grass clippings, limbs less than 5 feet long, leaves, untreated wooden pallets, and unpainted wooden pallets. **Note:** Sorry we cannot accept food scraps. For additional information on food waste, visit WipeOutWaste.com.

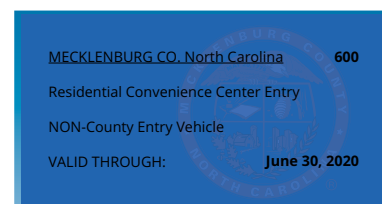
! Entry Window Stickers for Customers

Attention all customers...

All residential and non-residential vehicles must display a sticker that will determine the payment level for services, such as bulky items, tires, yard waste, construction and demolition services, and certain bagged trash disposal. The fee booth will assist you in getting your sticker. Non-Resident stickers can be purchased at the cashier's booth at each Full-Service Convenience Center – Foxhole, Hickory Grove, North Mecklenburg and Compost Central.

Red circles 	Non-Meck. County resident.	\$65	June 2020
Blue rectangle 	Meck. County resident	\$FREE	June 2020

- Your current blue & orange stickers are valid through June, 2020 even if they display an earlier date. All green stickers expire June 2019.
- If no sticker is displayed, you will pay based on the “orange” category.





YARD WASTE

VEHICLE TYPE

FEE (\$): RESIDENTS

· Any Vehicle with less than 2–32 gallon trash bags of Yard Waste	No Charge
· Any vehicle with more than 2–32 gallon trash bags of Yard Waste, but no loads piled higher than 2 feet	\$8.00/unit
· Any vehicle with built up sides; loads greater than 3 cubic yards, logs over 4 inch in diameter.	Vehicles Will be Weighed
· All vehicle types weighed	\$27.00/ton or \$8.00 load minimum



LOGS

For pick-up trucks or 8' trailers with a load not exceeding 2ft. high.



Logs up to 4" in diameter

\$8.00/unit or \$27.00/ton



Logs larger than 4" in diameter, but less than 24" in diameter*

Vehicles Will be Weighed at \$27.00/ton

*Loads of logs larger than 24" in diameter must use Compost Central or Foxhole Facility (see back for addresses & map).

NOTE:

- **1 unit = 1 load of material*** Ex: **Loaded vehicle + loaded trailer = 2 units**
 - *No vehicle longer than a standard sized pickup truck or vehicle/trailer combination with a payload quantity of greater than 3 yd³ will be accepted at the Recycling Centers for flat fee. Larger loads must be weighed to determine fee and may be directed to the Foxhole Landfill.
 - **Uncovered/Unsecured Loads:** All fees may be **increased by 50%** for any and all vehicles that enter County facilities with an uncovered or unsecured load.
- Vehicles using the weight scales but not using the facility for disposal shall pay a \$10 charge.

STICKERS

BLUE/RED=

Residential

· Blue Sticker (no charge)

· Red Sticker

\$65 (out of county)

Stickers are used to designate your Fee Category. In this residential brochure the fees are shown in Blue and Red.

Mecklenburg County residents are issued Blue Stickers; Out of County residents who purchase a Red Sticker will use the same fee category as Mecklenburg County residents.



CONSTRUCTION & BULKY WASTE

Vehicles May Be Weighed In/Out to Determine Exact Charges:

VEHICLE TYPE

FEE (\$): RESIDENTS

GROUP 1

- 1 Item Only Category: vehicles with any of the following: 1 large bulky item; such as a sofa, or a chair, or a table or Mattress Set. Only single items/ small amounts that are less than 2-96 gallon cans are eligible in this category. **If more than 1 item, see Group 2 below.**

No Charge

GROUP 2

- Vehicles with the Following: More than 1 bulky item; Loaded with more than 2-96 gallon cans; multiple items; vehicle loaded with more than 25% capacity. Any Work Vans (such as no side windows); Pick-up Trucks (without built up sides), Single axle trailers 8 ft or smaller, Units **MUST** be less than 3 cubic yards this category.

Bulky Waste: \$15/unit

Construction & Demolition
Debris: \$25/unit

GROUP 3

- All Vehicle Types Weighed
- Residential loads limited to 6 mattress/box springs at bulk rate

\$49.50/ton or
\$15 load minimum (Bulky Waste)
or \$25 load minimum (C&D)

NOTE:

- **Dirt, sod & concrete** are accepted at the **Foxhole Landfill from residential customers only, in small quantities only.** (Pickup trucks or 8ft trailers)
- Clean drywall (not painted) is accepted at full service sites for recycling; reduced fee rates are available at the Foxhole Landfill.
- **Carpet** and **carpet padding** are considered construction and demolition materials.
- Maximum delivery: 10 yd³ to Full Service Facility. Larger loads must go directly to Foxhole Landfill.



COMPOST & MULCH PRICES

DESCRIPTION

FEE (\$): ALL CUSTOMERS

Compost

- 1-29 yd³ \$18.63/yd³ + sales tax
- 30-99 yd³ \$18/yd³ + sales tax

Single hammer yard waste mulch

- 1-29 yd³ \$9.34/yd³ + sales tax
- 30-99 yd³ \$7.46/yd³ + sales tax
- 100+ yd³ \$6/yd³ + sales tax

Double hammer yard waste mulch \$15/yd³

Dump Truck Delivery

- Within 25 miles of Compost Central location \$95/load + cost of product
- Between 25 & 40 miles from Compost Central location \$125/load + cost of product

*For purchases greater than 100yd³, contact solidwaste@mecknc.gov as discounts may be available.

Bagged Compost \$3.25 Each

TIRES

A maximum of 15 automotive & light truck tires are accepted unless prior approval is granted. Excessively dirty tires may be subject to additional fees.

DESCRIPTION

FEE (\$): RESIDENTS

- Tires NOT on rims. Tires must be smaller than 20" bead diameter.
- Tires ON rims. Tires must be smaller than 20" bead diameter.

Up to 5 tires accepted at no charge. Each tire over 5: \$1/tire

\$2/tire



KITCHEN TRASH

Non-residential, Commercial & Business customers must pay for disposal of Kitchen Trash when delivered to Mecklenburg County Centers. Kitchen trash consists of general solid waste that is spoilsable types of waste and shall not include construction/demolition debris or yard wastes.

1-5 Thirty Two (32) Gallon Bags No Charge

6-15 Thirty Two (32) Gallon Bags \$8.00

16-25 Thirty Two (32) Gallon Bags \$12.00

Additional materials will require weighing in and out at \$34.50 per ton of materials delivered.

*There is a fee of \$25 per television/monitor from anyone in the "Orange" Fee Category. Computers are accepted at no charge.

CONDUCT AND VIDEO SURVEILLANCE

Please be aware that our staff will be courteous to all patrons. We respectfully seek the same from our customers. If a situation arises where a customer becomes unruly, curses or threatens our staff Mecklenburg County may take steps to ban that individual and company from using Mecklenburg County disposal locations. All transactions are video taped and recorded for your safety as well as ours.
