



FAQ's Every Child Can Swim Program:

1. What is the Every Child Can Swim Program?

The Every Child Can Swim Program was created by Mecklenburg County Park and Recreation Department to provide FREE swim lessons to help ensure that every child can swim. These lessons are at the beginner level, with emphasis on water safety.

2. What ages can participate?

Ages 3-12.

3. How do I register my child for FREE swim lessons?

Registration will be held on May 28th, 2019 at the West Charlotte Recreation Center located at 2401 Kendall Dr. You will check-in with staff between 5:00-6:00 PM. Please make sure that the child you want to register is present at time of registration. All registration sheets must be turned in by 6:00 PM.

4. How does the lottery system work?

Once you turn in your registration form you will receive a ticket. Beginning at 6:00 PM the lottery drawing will begin. You must be present at the time of the drawing in order to accept your spot. Tickets will be called until all spots have been filled.

5. When will the lessons take place?

Lessons will take place during the week on Tuesday/Thursday evenings, and on Saturday mornings. For the June session, lessons will begin on Saturday, June 8th, 2019.

6. Where will the lessons be held?

Lessons will be held at the West Charlotte High School Swimming Pool located at 2219 Senior Dr.

7. What does my child need to bring to the lesson?

Please make sure that your child is dressed in their bathing suit prior to arrival, and has a towel and shoes as we are not able to use the locker rooms.
