



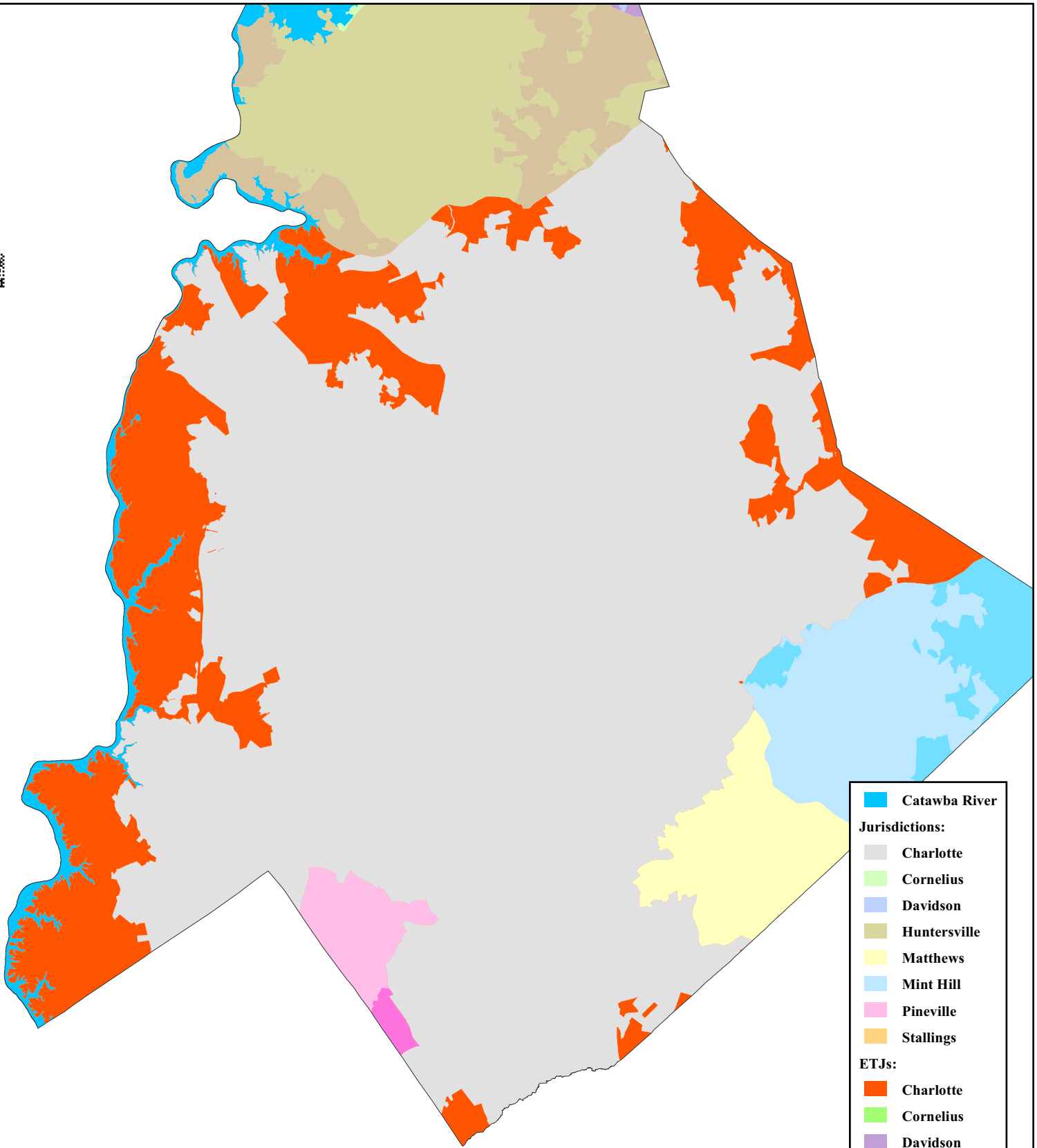
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED MECKLENBURG COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICE DISTRICT WITHIN THE EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION AREA OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE, N.C.

Notice is hereby given that the Mecklenburg Board of County Commissioners will hold a public hearing regarding the creation of a Law Enforcement Service District covering the unincorporated land use planning areas of the City of Charlotte, N.C., the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction area (ETJ) within Mecklenburg County. A map defining the boundaries of the unincorporated land use planning area is included with this notice. A report containing the following information is also available for public inspection at the Clerk to the Board's office from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. located at the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center, 11th floor, 600 East Fourth Street, Charlotte, N.C.:

- (1) a map of the proposed district, showing its proposed boundaries;
- (2) a statement showing that the proposed district meets the standards set out in G.S. 153A-302(a);
- (3) a plan for providing one or more of the services listed in G.S. 153A-301 to the district; and
- (4) a proposal to eliminate the current County-wide unincorporated area law enforcement service district if this new district is created.

The public hearing will be held on Tuesday, May 1, 2018 at 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the agenda allows in the Meeting Chamber of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center located at 600 East Fourth Street, Charlotte, N.C.
