International Travel

The State Department has issued a [Global Level 4 Health Advisory](#) – Do Not Travel.

The Department of State advises U.S. citizens to avoid all international travel due to the global impact of COVID-19. In countries where commercial departure options remain available, U.S. citizens who live in the United States should arrange for immediate return to the United States, unless they are prepared to remain abroad for an indefinite period.

Travel in the United States

There are a no specific advisories or restrictions for travel within the United States. However, a growing number of cases of COVID-19 have been reported in every state, and many areas are experiencing community spread of disease. Crowded travel settings, like airports, may increase your risk of exposure to COVID-19 if there are other travelers with coronavirus. *As such, Mecklenburg County is recommending that residents avoid non-essential travel.*
